

Golf in the Desert – Where Stunning Views Meet Exceptional Play

Established officially in 1973, Osoyoos Golf Club brings together ideal desert climate and picturesque golf with two full-length courses boasting the longest season in the Okanagan. The Park Meadows course is a pleasurable “resort-style” course that is walker friendly amidst a park-like setting, while the Desert Gold course brings a new and unique links-style golf experience.

Perched high above the Town of Osoyoos and sculpted in the environs of a desert mountainside, golfers will be rewarded by precision shot making and captivated by views of Osoyoos and its surrounding orchards, vineyards, and Lake Osoyoos below. The courses were built with a keen eye on the environmental protection of the unique antelope brush ecosystem and the Club established a desert sanctuary area to protect and preserve the habitat for the future. A state of the art irrigation system maintains the lush playing conditions throughout the heat of the summer.



Osoyoos Golf Club is a semi-private club, always open to the public, that offers membership opportunities. We are confident the Osoyoos Golf Club will become your golf destination of choice. OGC History...



Play initially began on nine holes designed by Jack Reimer in April of 1973. The course was an instant success and by, 1979 a second nine was urgently needed to accommodate the growing number of members and visitors wanting to play the course. Again Mr. Jack Reimer was contacted to design and build the additional holes, and in April of 1981 the Club was a full 18 holes.


The popularity of the game, and the course, allowed for the addition of a third nine. Boyd Barr designed and constructed the new holes that opened in the fall of 1994. The three nines appropriately named the "Park", the "Meadows" & the "Desert" each provide a unique golf experience and in combination they offer many varied 18 hole rounds!



After many years of expanding and renovating of the original clubhouse the Club sensibly moved forward again with the construction of a magnificent new 13,000 sq ft clubhouse which opened in 2001. Providing dining rooms and extensive patio decks overlooking the greens, fairways and Osoyoos Lake itself, the Mediterranean inspired clubhouse design has become an icon of the "new Osoyoos".

Never able to stand still, in 2005 the members of the Osoyoos Golf Club voted to expand to 36 holes and in August of 2006, the Desert Gold Course was opened to rave reviews.



Executive Unlimited Membership

- Unlimited golf with a six (6) day advance booking privilege. Enter ballot 7 to 14 days in advance.
- Membership in Provincial & National Golf Associations.
- Access to the Golf Canada handicap system.
- A charge account for the purchase of Pro Shop merchandise and Food & Beverage purchases.
- Regular and Charter Members are entitled to hold office and have the right to vote at Society meetings.



Intermediate Membership (19 to 39)

- Unlimited golf with a six (6) day advance booking privilege. Enter ballot 7 to 14 days in advance.
- Membership in Provincial & National Golf Associations.
- Access to the Golf Canada handicap system.
- A charge account for the purchase of Pro Shop merchandise and Food & Beverage purchases.
- Regular and Charter Members are entitled to hold office and have the right to vote at Society meetings.



Retainer Membership

- Executive members who can not play a regular season for **accepted reasons** but wish to retain their Club Membership.
- Any golf played while on retainer is at regular “public” green fee rates.
- A charge account for the purchase of Pro Shop merchandise and Food & Beverage purchases.
- Access to the Golf Canada handicap system.

Membership Categories Continued



25 Round | 9 or 18 Holes

- Includes the Membership Retaining fee plus 25 rounds.
- Regular “public” green fee rates apply after use of rounds
- Unlimited golf with a six (6) day advance booking privilege. Enter ballot 7 to 14 days in advance.
- Membership in Provincial & National Golf Associations.
- Access to the Golf Canada handicap system.
- A charge account for the purchase of Pro Shop merchandise and Food & Beverage purchases.
- Unused rounds do not carry over.



University/Student Membership (19 to 24)

- Must be enrolled in a full time program at a recognized college/university during the term immediately preceding the membership season.
- Unlimited golf with a six (6) day advance booking privilege. Enter ballot 7 to 14 days in advance.
- Membership in Provincial & National Golf Associations.
- Access to the Golf Canada handicap system.
- No charging privileges will be provided.



Junior Membership

- Must be under 19 years of age at the time of application, be in full time attendance at a local elementary or secondary school or be under the care of parents or legal guardians who are full playing Members of the Club.
- Unlimited golf with a six (6) day advance booking privilege. The Pro Shop may exercise discretion during busy periods.
- Juniors under 13 years of age must golf “under supervision” of a responsible adult unless granted special privileges by Professional Staff.
- Golf Canada membership is included.




