SUPPLEMENTAL LOCAL RULES & TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS
MAY 24, 2026**



Welcome to the 2026 Osoyoos Golf Club, Spring Mixed Scramble. We appreciate everyone who has taken the time to support this tournament and their golf club.

Play is governed by the **Golf Canada Rules of Golf** and the following local rules. Ignore local rules on any scorecard or hard card. Unless otherwise noted, the penalty for breach of a local rule or condition is **two strokes**.

TOURNAMENT DIVISIONS

- There are three flights. Net prizes will be distributed in each flight based on total tournament entries.
 - **25%** of combined team handicap will be applied

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Four Player Team Mixed Scramble (net):

- Each member tees off. Select appropriate drive.
 - Move all balls to the selected spot, one club length, same cut, no closer to the hole. The ball must remain in the hazard if it is chosen. Continue this process for each shot.
 - On greens, mark ball within 6 inches of spot, no closer to the hole.
 - **Each player must use 3 drives leaving** (6 freebies). Mark clearly with an X which player's drive was chosen.
 - Record the gross team score on the score card provided.

SCORING

- At least one player per group is required use the **Golf Genius** tournament app to score for their team (GGID code will be provided).
 - Record your gross team score on the app and on your scorecard.
 - Scorecards will be distributed at registration before each round.
 - Following play, scores must be verified at the **scoring area at the Pro Shop**.
 - Each scorecard must be **signed by the contestant** and left with the scoring team for final submission.

TOURNAMENT RULES IN EFFECT

- **Summer Rules**
 - The tournament will be played under Summer Rules, meaning the ball must be played as it lies, without adjustment or improvement of the lie, stance, or area of intended swing, except as permitted by the Rules of Golf. No preferred lies or lift, clean, and place provisions will be in effect unless otherwise stated by the Tournament Committee.

PRIZING (subject to change):

Team Prizing:

There will be net prizes awarded to each flight, based on total tournament entries.

On Course Competitions:

- Men KP – Hole #7 & #12 | Women KP – Hole #3 & #10
- Men LP – Hole #3 | Women LP – Hole #17

Wine Draw:

- To enter the draw, simply bring a bottle of wine (minimum \$15 value before taxes) to registration on the day of the tournament.
- For every bottle entered, you'll receive one entry into the draw.
- Multiple draws will be held throughout the dinner banquet—each winner will take home a selection of wine!
